Trevor started working on the threshing crews at a young age and especially enjoyed working for the Glasier family.

Trevor joined the Army and served for two years. He returned home to help his father farm and farmed until his health wouldn't allow it any longer. Trevor took great pride in his farm and his cattle. He also took very good care of his dogs and cats. Trevor and Tom Evans did much of their farming together, so the Evans girls were very lucky to have almost had a second father so close by.

Trevor took good care of his business and was a very good neighbor.

Trevor enjoyed relatively good health with the exception of his hearing until January 2009 when his health quickly turned worse and he was forced to move into Designated Supportive Living in March 2009 and then on April 28, 2011 he moved again to Long Term Care, until his passing on August 6, 2011.
